

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (2016/679 - GDPR)

In Brief :

We process your personal data to provide you with our Process Communication Model services and products in accordance with applicable terms and conditions.

Your data is kept for three years and then anonymised.

We do not provide any data to third parties other than the local Process Communication Model distributor and only the distributor in your country.

We do not transmit any of your data to a third country outside Europe, unless you are a resident of that country and are dependent on a local distributor. In that case, only he or she has access to your data.

All Process Communication Model certified trainers and coaches are asked to delete your data at the end of the coaching and/or training.

PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED

Personal data refers to data that identifies you as a natural person. We may process the following types of personal data about you:

- Your contact information including your name, email address and phone number

This information may include IP number, device type and browser, time zone, geographic location, as well as your interests and preferences information about how you interact with our services, for example about the features used and buttons clicked on.

Processing purposes

We process your personal data for the following purposes:
